- According to our passage, what is the main point the writer of Hebrews is trying to make with his emphasis on Melchizedek? Why is that point important for Christians to hear?
- What is weak and useless about the law according to this passage? How does the Gospel bring a better hope? According to our passage this hope allows us to draw near to God, describe a time when you have felt particularly near to God. What caused that nearness?
- In what ways is Jesus a better priest than those under the Jewish system?
- What does it mean that Jesus makes intercession for us? Why is this Good News?
- How is Jesus described in verse 26? Why is the fact that Jesus' sacrifice is "once for all" important?

DISCUSS-Hebrews 8

- In verse 5, the writer of Hebrews suggests that Old Testament sacrificial system and the tabernacle were "copies and shadows of the heavenly things." What does this mean? How does this change the way that we should read the Old Testament?
- In what specific ways does the Old Testament priesthood and sacrificial system prefigure and point forward to Jesus?
- What is the covenant that Jesus has mediated? What are the better promises on which it is based? What four promises do you see in the quote from Jeremiah 31?
- What does verse 13 mean? What about the Old Covenant is obsolete? Why should
 Christians still obey the Ten Commandments, for example?

- Read verse 14. Why do you think purity matters so much to God? What do you feel when you hear that Jesus declares that you are pure?
- Read Psalm 51:4. How is David's view of his sin different than ours? Read Hebrews 9:24. Why is it necessary for Jesus to come before the Father on our behalf?
- Why is verse 27 important? How does it create urgency?
- Read verse 28. If you truly believed that Jesus has sealed you for an eternity, how would your life look different? How would your life be different if you truly believed that Jesus' sacrifice was "once for all" as it relates to your sin?

- The "therefore" in verse 19 signals that the writer of Hebrews is giving us a point of application to all this theology that he has been writing about. What should we do in light of the truths that the writer of Hebrews has presented? What does it mean to have a true heart and a full assurance of faith? What does it mean to hold fast to the confession of our hope? What does it mean to stir one another up to love and good works? What is one practical application point for your life this week in light of these verses?
- Describe a time when someone else has stirred you up to love and good works.
 Why is it easy in our culture to neglect meeting together? Who is one person that you are going to encourage this week?

- According to this passage, when did Abraham exercise faith? What was Abraham looking forward to in faith?
- Read verses 32 to 38 again. How do these verses make you feel?
- According to this chapter, what is the main point of the Old Testament?
- How is our faith better than the faith of those in the Old Testament? How is it the same?
