

Community (Acts 2:42-47)

CONNECT—Think of a fun-icebreaker question to ask. For example, what item are you wearing that is significant?

DISCUSS

What most stood out to you from Clayton's sermon this past week? What was one of your big takeaways?

What strikes you about Acts 2:42-47? Is there something that particularly resonates with you or is particularly confusing to you?

What are some ways that you have experience "awe" of how God was working in someone's life? Your life?

The new converts in the passage became radically generous with others because of how Jesus is generous. How has the generosity of Jesus impact your generosity with your time, talent, and treasure? How does a proper view of the gospel compel us to be generous?

Read John 3:1-8. According to Jesus, what does it mean that we have been made alive? How is this a different picture of salvation than we hear in a lot of churches?

How does being in community with other believers help you encounter Jesus at a deeper level?

As scary as it is, how can being fully known to someone bring you closer to Jesus and point you to the gospel?

Read 1 John 4:18-19. Fear has to do with punishment. Are you punishing yourself from truly experience all that God has for you? How can love cast out that fear? Since Jesus loves us first, how does that impact how we love others?

RELATE—Consider splitting into guys and girls for this section.
